

The Waste Hierarchy

Prevention. We'll help you minimise your waste output

Re-use. We'll help you extend the lifecycle of your existing materials

Recycling. We'll give your unwanted materials a new purpose

Recovery. We'll recover valuable resources (e.g. energy) from your non-recyclables

Disposal. This refers to landfill; we aim to send absolutely none of your materials here




When it comes to recycling, getting your storage solutions right is vital, both for your bottom line and for the planet.

Regular collections

On-demand collections




Multi-site contracts

Our confidential shredding service

We created our confidential shredding service over 20 years ago as a way to help our customers remain compliant, keep their data safe and their reputation intact. We hold the highest certifications for the sector, have highly trained, security vetted staff and top of the range shredding machinery monitored by 24-hour CCTV. Once destroyed, we also recycle or recover all shredded materials. So, in short, you're in safe (and sustainable) hands with us.

We shred the following materials:







Hard drives & media materials



Branded uniforms, badges & clothing

Did you know? The roof on our high-security shredding facility contains solar panels, which supply 50% of the power needed to operate our shredding machinery.

Waste into energ

As it stands, not everything is recyclable and these non-recyclable items (aka general waste) often end up in landfill doing damage to the environment.

To us, this wasn't acceptable, so we sought to find an eco-friendly alternative. This means, instead of sending to landfill, we send nonrecyclables to Waste-to-Energy, where they are converted into electricity. In doing so, we've also helped turn many of our customers zero to landfill.

For every 1100L bin of your non-recyclables, we can help you generate enough energy to:



Produce 4,200 cups of tea or coffee



Power a 10kW electric shower for almost 5 hours



Power almost 4 months of battery life on a laptop
